

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

This Intergovernmental Agreement (“IGA”) is entered into this ____ day of _____, 2010, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Colorado (the “County”) and the Douglas County Rural Water Authority (the “Authority”).

WHEREAS, the County diligently supports water conservation efforts and planning for all Douglas County residents and is willing to help fund significant water conservation and planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is dedicated to water planning and conservation efforts and has requested funding from the County for fiscal year 2010; and

WHEREAS, the County is willing to provide funding so long as certain goals and efforts are agreed to be pursued by the Authority for completion in 2010; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provision of C.R.S. § 29-1-203, the County and the Authority may cooperate and contract to provide such functions and services as noted herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED by the County and the Authority as follows:

1. The County shall pay one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000.00) to the Authority for 2010 on or before _____ for fiscal year 2010. The Authority understands that any future funding is subject to the County approving such contribution through their annual budget and appropriation.

2. The Authority shall prepare a report detailing the water consumption characteristics of its members during Irrigation Years 2008 and 2009. The report shall include the following water provider data: total water production by source of supply (i.e.: nontributary and not-nontributary Denver basin aquifer groundwater, tributary groundwater, tributary groundwater, surface water, purchased water and leased water supplies and non-potable water use), an estimate of system losses, a summary of the amounts of types of water used via direct wastewater reuse and indirect reuse via a plan for augmentation of exchange(s).

3. The County shall provide population estimates for the service area of each member of the Authority for irrigation years 2008 and 2009.

4. The Authority shall prepare a report summarizing the per capita water for each member and the new water per capita water demand computed as total water use minus direct and indirect reuse divided by the service population.

5. The Authority shall prepare a summary of water conservation activities of each member.

6. The Authority shall cooperate with the County and work to ensure that all members of the Authority have a Colorado Water Conservation Board approved water conservation plan by December 31, 2010 and shall report to the County periodically during 2010 as to its progress in achieving this goal.

7. The Authority shall specify other work plans of the Authority and provide basic detail and metrics regarding their contents and success reporting.

8. The County and the Authority shall meet as necessary during 2010 to discuss progress towards goals.

9. Notices to be provided under this IGA shall be given in writing and either delivered by hand or deposited in the U. S. mail with sufficient postage to the following addressees:
